**Subject: Submission of Pending Compliance Forms/Reports for PAT Cycle-IV & V in View of Upcoming ESCerts Trading -reg.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to the Perform, Achieve and Trade (PAT) Cycle-IV and PAT Cycle-V, covering the compliance period from FY 2018-19 to FY 2021-22. As you are aware, under the PAT Scheme—implemented pursuant to the provisions of the **Energy Conservation Act, 2001**—every DCs is **statutorily obligated** to submit the prescribed compliance documents through the PATNet Portal. These submissions constitute a critical requirement under Sections 14, 15, 26 and related provisions of the Act, which also empower the imposition of **penalties for non-compliance**.

2. BEE is presently in the process to commence **ESCerts Trading for PAT Cycle-IV and V from the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of January 2026**.
3. Before the commencement of trading, it is imperative that **all DCs complete their compliance submissions** on the PATNet Portal and that **SDAs** review these submissions and record their comments/observations as part of the statutory verification process. It is a matter of concern that a substantial number of compliance documents remain pending at your level, **leading to delay in the overall process**.
4. In view of the above, and considering the mandatory compliance obligations stipulated under the Energy Conservation Act, 2001, you are hereby requested to ensure that the all pending compliance documents must be submitted on the PATNet Portal **latest by 21st December 2025**, so as to meet the statutory requirements of the PAT Scheme and prevent any consequences arising from non-compliance. **Continued pendency may attract action as per the penalty provisions stipulated under the Energy Conservation Act, 2001**.
