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Overview on PATNet and DCRM Portals....

PATNet is the portal developed for Designated Consumers (DCs), Empaneled Energy Accredited Energy Auditor (EmAEA) and State Designated Agency (SDA) – Technical Officer(TO) and Nodal Officer (NO). This portal is used essentially by the all to file, verify and commenting on the forms as part of PAT.

Important points for ESCerts Trading

- Energy Saving Certificates abbreviated as ESCerts is dealt only in Electronic form on our portal named as PATNet portal.
- ESCerts once issued to any of the DC in a particular Cycle shall remain valid till the compliance of that particluar DC.
- For example: any DC is issued ESCerts in PAT II and he is again nominated as a DC in PAT VII, then validity of that ESCerts shall be from PAT II till the compliance period of PAT VII i.e. on submission of the Form D.
- ESCerts once sold cannot be resold.
- Buyer buying excess ESCerts will have the validity till his next compliance Cycle.
- For Example: If a buyer is buying any ESCerts in excess, the validity will automatically be till buyers next PAT cycle which may be PAT VII or PAT VIII.
- The value of one energy savings certificate shall be equal to one metric ton of oil equivalent of energy consumed.
- The ESCerts purchased by a DC for the purpose of compliance with the energy consumption norms and standards shall after their submission to BEE stand expired.
- For trading of ESCerts, no floor price or forbearance price has been defined as the price of ESCerts shall be discovered at the power exchanges (PXIL and IEX).
- The bidding mechanism used by the Power Exchanges as per approved Business Rules is " Double Sided Closed Auction."

Important points for ESCerts Trading

- Section 14A (1) of Energy Conservation Act 2001 gives power to Central Government to issue energy savings certificate to the designated consumer whose energy consumption is less than the prescribed norms and standards.
- The Power Exchanges are regulated by CERC and with respect to the powers conferred to CERC under section 66 and sub-section (1) as well as clause (y) of sub-section (2) of section 178 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Central Commission can make the regulations for the development of market (including trading) in power sector.
- Value of one ESCert is equal to one metric ton of oil equivalent of energy consumed. The value of per metric ton of oil equivalent of energy consumed shall be prescribed by Central Government, in consultation with BEE, under Section 14 B of the Energy Conservation Act 2001.
- As per PAT Rules amendment dated 31, March 2016, the value of per metric ton of oil equivalent for 2014-15 was Rs.
 10968 and the value of per metric ton of oil equivalent for 2018-19 is Rs 18402.
- Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Dealing in Energy Savings Certificates) Regulations, 2016 was issued by CERC on 27th May, 2016 and notified on 30th May, 2016.
- BEE (Administrator) had developed the detailed procedure for transaction of ESCerts in consultation with POSOCO (Registry) and on 14th February 2017, the Procedure was approved by the Commission.
- Modification in the procedure is done in August,2021.
- On **24th March 2017**, CERC approved the Fee order for transaction of ESCerts.
- Renewal of the Fee Order was done in **March,2021**. There is no change in Fee structure.

Important points for ESCerts Trading

- DCs who are already an Eligible Entity, need not to become the Eligible Entity again.
- DCs as Eligible Entity can trade their banked ESCerts without any payment.
- DCs as Eligible Entity needs to pay the ESCerts Fees for introducing their new ESCerts Issued in PAT cycle II.
- DCs who are already an eligible entity needs to submit the documents again on PATNet as trading has started after due long period, hence DCs shall update the documents.
- As per the modifications done in Procedure, DCs can introduce their ESCerts in slots.
- DCs who wants to become the Eligible entity has to pay both the Registration Fee and ESCerts Fee.
- Registration Fees @ Rs 15000/- per plant / Unit of a DC.
- ESCerts Fees @ Rs 5/ESCerts.
- Blocked ESCerts means ESCerts being blocked for their compliance in PAT Cycle II for buyers. For ex. DC having 1000 banked ESCerts from PAT Cycle I but in PAT Cycle II entitle to purchase 600 ESCerts. Then automatically 600 banked ESCerts
 remaining 400 can be sold.
